



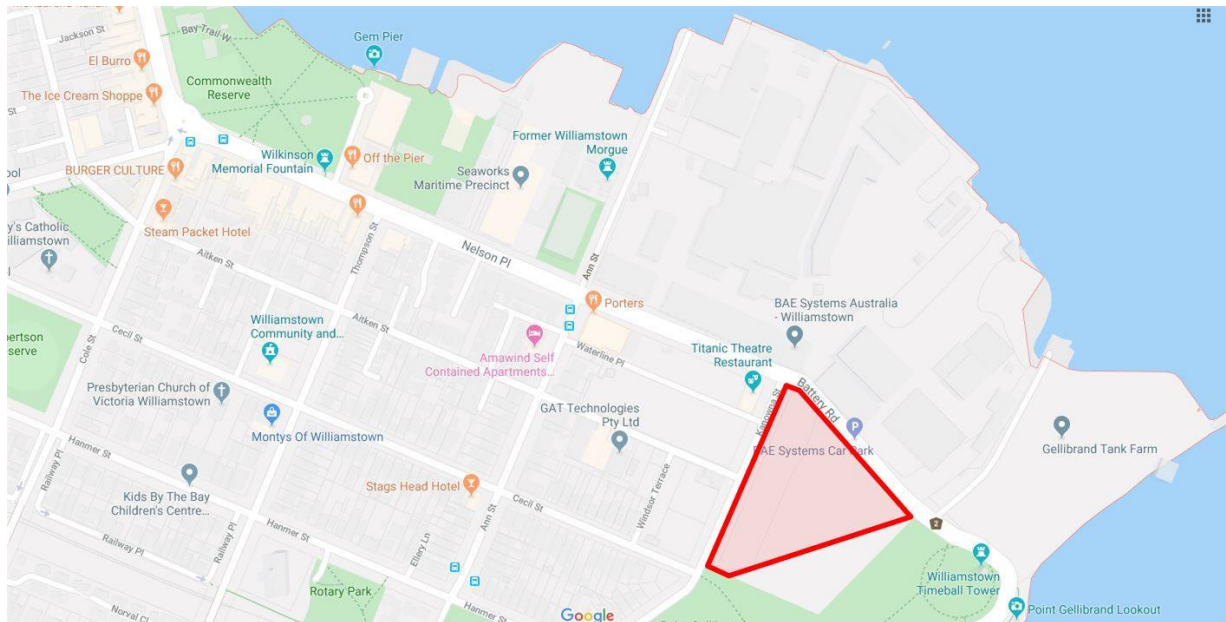
Competitor Information and Social Program

Parking

Parking at Royal Yacht Club of Victoria is reserved for RYCV Full Members. Competitors will be permitted to enter the premises to unload their boats and then will have to find local parking.

There is limited free parking in surrounding streets. Most local parking is paid and timed. There will be free competitor parking at BAE.

Please note that entry and exit will be from Battery Rd only, speed limits apply as per signage and vehicles are left on the BAE site at the vehicle owners' risk.

Any support boats can be launched at Warmies Boat Ramp, which is free to use.

Access for dinghy drop off at RYCV is via Syme St.

Junior dinghies are usually launched from one of the 2 boat ramps at RYCV, while larger dinghies and skiffs are launched from the boat ramp at Seaworks. Please see map for details.
